As the Maintenance Engineer, you will be tasked with planning, coordinating, and scheduling major asset maintenance and rehabilitation activities in order to support the delivery of reliable Wastewater Treatment Plant operations. Primary duties include:

- Improve the cost effectiveness of plant maintenance and rehabilitation operations and extend the service life of plant assets.
- Provide plant maintenance engineering and asset management technical support for wastewater treatment plant operation and maintenance.
- Research, develop, implement and help in the understanding of asset management concepts.
- Review and maintain asset life cycle profiles for key assets, analyzing historical asset performance, and developing long-term asset rehabilitation requirements.

Qualifications

- A degree in Engineering.
- Registration as a Professional Engineer in Canada, and current licensure as a Professional Engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA) by the first day of work.
- At least 4 years of relevant P.Eng experience in maintenance management, and asset rehabilitation is required.
- A valid Class 5 Driver's Licence (or provincial equivalent) or a Graduated Driver's License (GDL) and access to a personal vehicle for business use is required.
- Knowledge of asset life cycle management and predictive maintenance techniques will be considered assets.
- Project management experience will be considered an asset
- You are an excellent communicator, who works effectively within a group setting.
- You demonstrate strong analytical skills and the ability to identify and research new industrial trends and technology.
