Reporting to the Commissioner, Public Works, the Director, Water and Wastewater Services (Director) will provide direction for Niagara's water & wastewater services, ensuring the long-term delivery of sustainable, effective, and affordable services to the region. The Director provides strategic and operational leadership in the delivery of regional services and is also accountable for medium to long range people resource planning for the division, determining ideal organizational structures, identifying desirable role and skill mix requirements and ensuring ongoing work quality and deliverability of results. The Director is accountable for the development, management and administration of annual and multi-year capital and operating budgets for the division, ensuring support of Council's objectives, financial transparency, and compliance with corporate financial policies.

The successful candidate holds a post-secondary degree in Applied Science, Engineering, or other relevant area of study, coupled with 10+ years of senior management and leadership experience directing the activities of a large and complex operation, preferably within the municipal sector or other unionized public service. The Director will be a licensed Professional Engineer (P. Eng) with the Professional Engineers of Ontario (PEO) or hold certification with the Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists (OACETT) as a Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T.), and ideally have MOE Class IV Wastewater Treatment and MOE Class IV Wastewater Collection certificates.
