This one-of-a-kind water sector conference will be a virtual event this time around, broadcast live for 4.5 hours each day. Registration will open in March.

With the theme of *Bridging the Gap*, the event will feature critical recommendations and resources utilities need to protect their consumers, assets, and the environment.

Attendees will learn about:

- Physical security threats and mitigations,
- Climate-related disaster response and recovery,
- Cybersecurity foundational knowledge, and
- Advanced cybersecurity best practices.

Speakers will include thought leaders and subject-matter experts from:

- Water and wastewater utilities,
- Private firms with unique knowledge on security and resilience, and
- Federal and state agencies.

Who should attend?

- Wastewater and drinking water utility managers and staff—
 - Executives, IT and OT staff, resiliency and risk managers, and operational staff needing more substantial security awareness;
- Government agencies with water sector constituencies; and
- Private firms and technical assistance providers that support utilities in their security and resilience efforts.

The event will be recorded for those who cannot attend.

Registration fees will range from \$0 for small utilities to perhaps \$200 for private companies.
