As a Project Engineer you will be responsible for developing and implementing a wide range of engineering, technical, contract management and project management assignments at Bonnybrook and within the division. Primary duties include:

- Engage engineering consultants to complete functional, pre-design and detailed design assignments for a variety of capital projects at the City's wastewater treatment plants.
- Liaise and coordinate with Water Services Operation and Maintenance to meet their requirements and to ensure the required handover documentation is completed.
- Work closely with other City business Units, including Supply Management, Law, Infrastructure Planning, Strategic Services, etc to ensure all contractual, legal and regulatory requirements are met for the procurement of equipment, consulting engineering assignments, and construction contracts.
- Participate in the preparation of commissioning plans and the commissioning of projects.
- Manage consultant assignments, supply contracts, construction contracts and all work in accordance with the City's Project Management Framework.
- Review engineering reports, contract drawings and specifications.
- Prepare budgets, schedules, project status and issues/risk status, including monthly updates.
- Apply safety legislation in all aspects of work.

Qualifications

- A degree in a related field in Engineering, registration as a Professional Engineer in Canada, and current licensure as a Professional Engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA) or licensure by the first day of work.
- At least 3 years of relevant experience as a Professional Engineer.
- Preference may be given to applicants that possess a post graduate degree in wastewater treatment.
- A valid class 5 driver's licence and the use of a personal vehicle for business use is required.
- Knowledge of current design standards, wastewater treatment and environmental standards will be essential for success.
- Excellent communication skills, tendering and administrating projects, and monitoring the work of consultants.
