Verification is an objective, evidence-based approach that lends credibility to your project, and it showcases that the project is aligned with your community's needs and expectations.

THE ENVISION FRAMEWORK

Envision® is a holistic sustainability framework and rating system that enables a thorough examination of the sustainability and resiliency of all types of infrastructure, including water & wastewater. It is a comprehensive tool that can assist government agencies and their consultants and contractors in delivering infrastructure that tackles the climate crisis, addresses public health and safety needs, cultivates social equity and justice, creates jobs, and spurs economic recovery.

ENVISION IN CANADA

Envision has been used in Canada since it was first released in 2012 and is being applied to dozens of projects across the country. Seventeen projects have completed verification and earned Envision awards, and several more are registered for verification. Envision-awarded project examples:

- STM's New Entrance Building – Vendôme Metro Station
- Red Deer Water Treatment Plant Residuals Management Facility
- York Region's 2nd Concession Project
- Grand Bend Area Wastewater Treatment Facility

- Vancouver's Northeast False Creek Renewal & Development
- Surrey's Biofuel Facility
